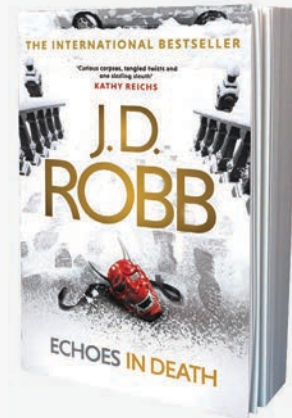
Enter the world of One Folgate Street and discover perfection...but is it worth the price?

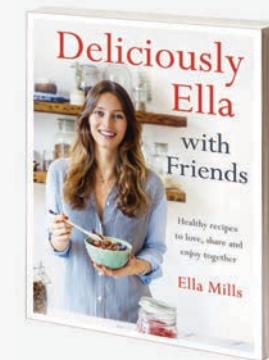


### **Caraval**
