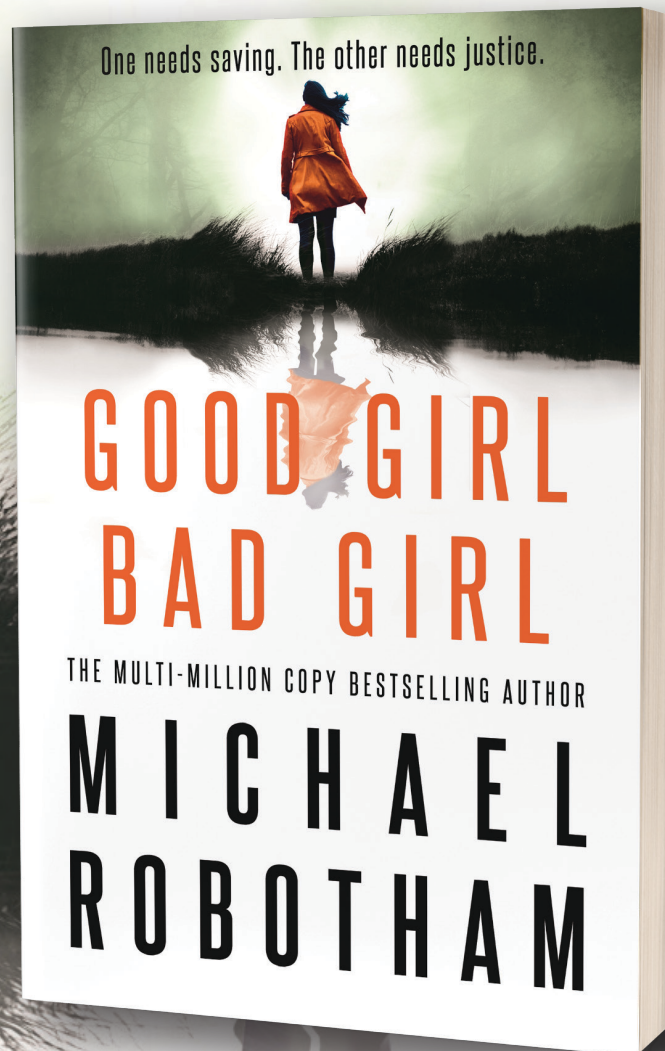

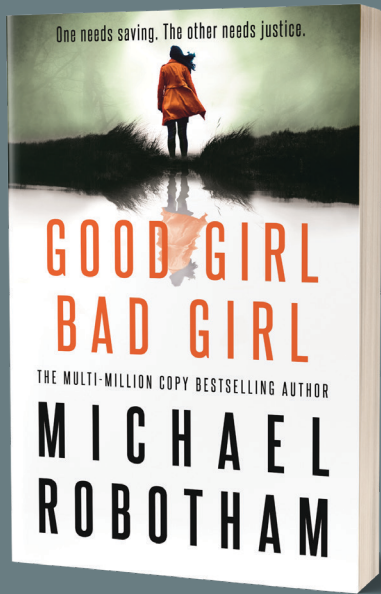

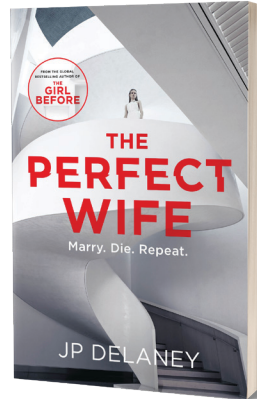
Good Girl, Bad Girl

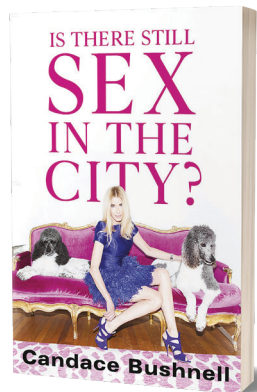

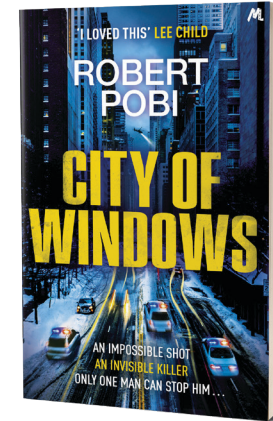


Is There Still Sex in the City?

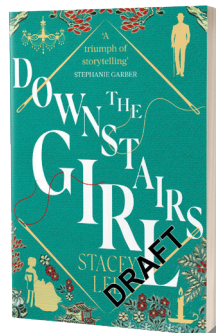


The Shelly Bay Ladies Swimming Circle

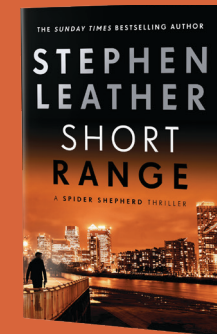


The Downstairs Girl
