The Last Living Cannibal

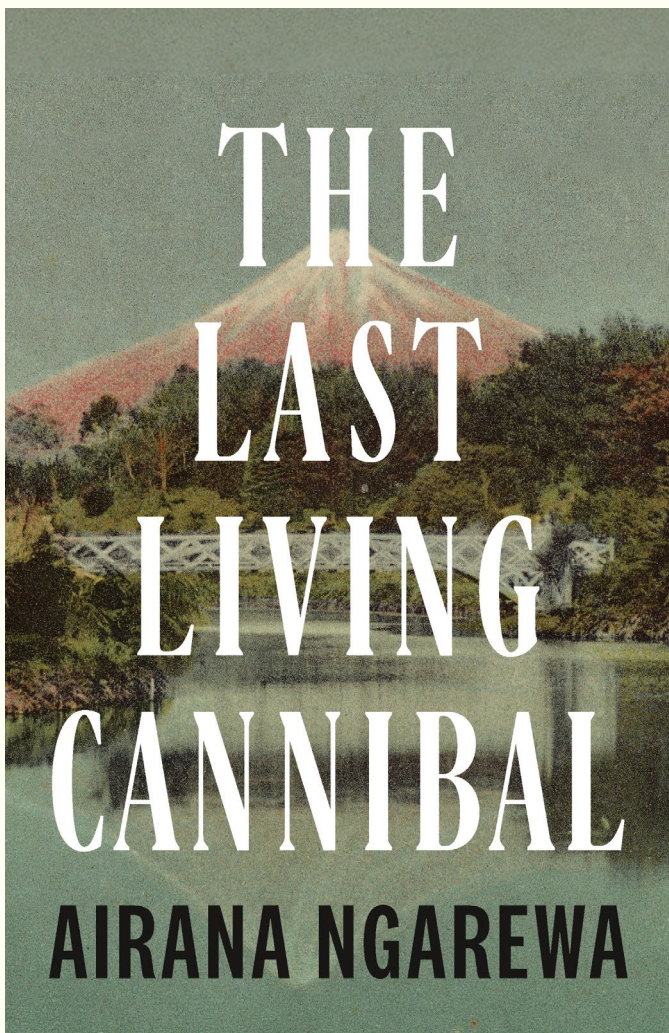

Muru is not revenge. Muru is about balance. You put your hands on one of theirs and they had every right to take from you and yours whatever they meant to take, short of a life.

Aotearoa in the 1940s, and the Māori men of Taranaki have refused to join the Māori battalion because of the severity of their land confiscations. Koko is the oldest man in the village, a legend within his community - he's lived through the land wars, Parihaka, imprisonment in Dunedin, and they whisper of him as the Last Living Cannibal. Koko dotes on his grandson Blackie, who has lived with him ever since Blackie's mum left in troubling circumstances years earlier. But the ghosts of the past are bound to come calling, and when they do, they come with muru in mind.

Richly set in Taranaki during the 1940s, *The Last Living Cannibal* is the epitome of a classic Aotearoa novel, from one of this generation's most promising writers.

Born and raised in Pātea, **Airana Ngarewa** (Ngati Ruanui, Nga Rauru, Ngaruahine) is the author of the bestselling novel *The Bone Tree*. He won the short story and poetry competitions at the Ronald Hugh Morrieson Literary Awards in 2022. His writing has also been published by RNZ, NZ Herald, Newsroom and Landfall.



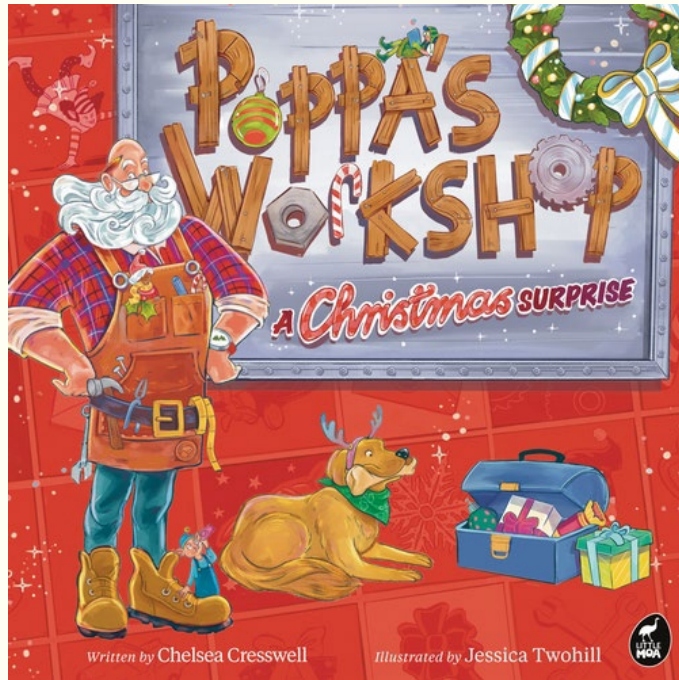

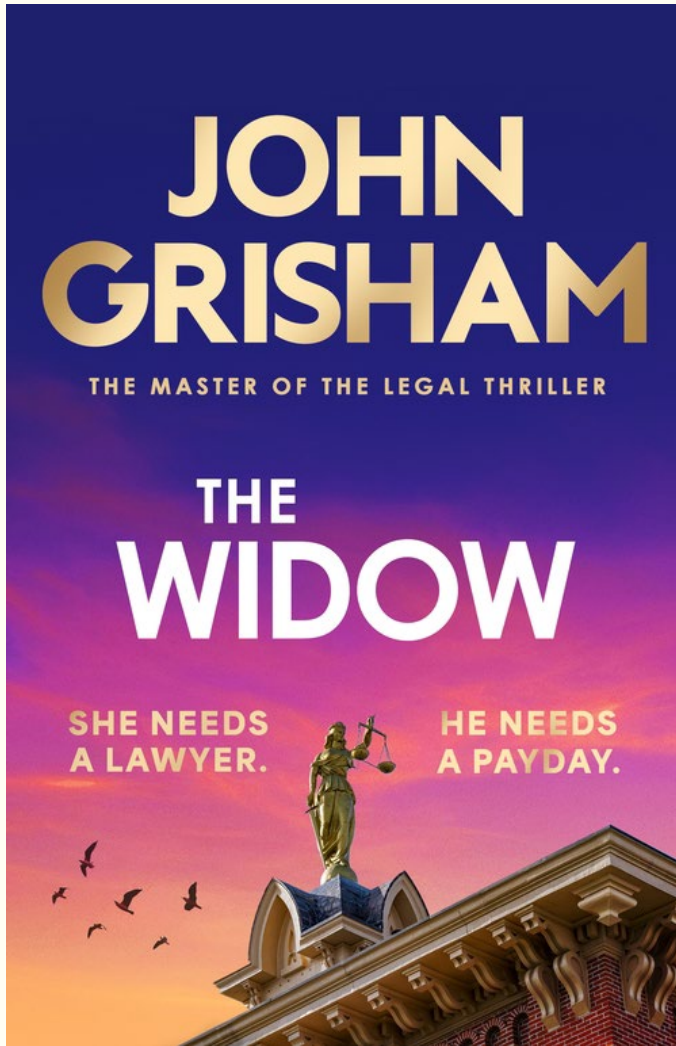

The Widow

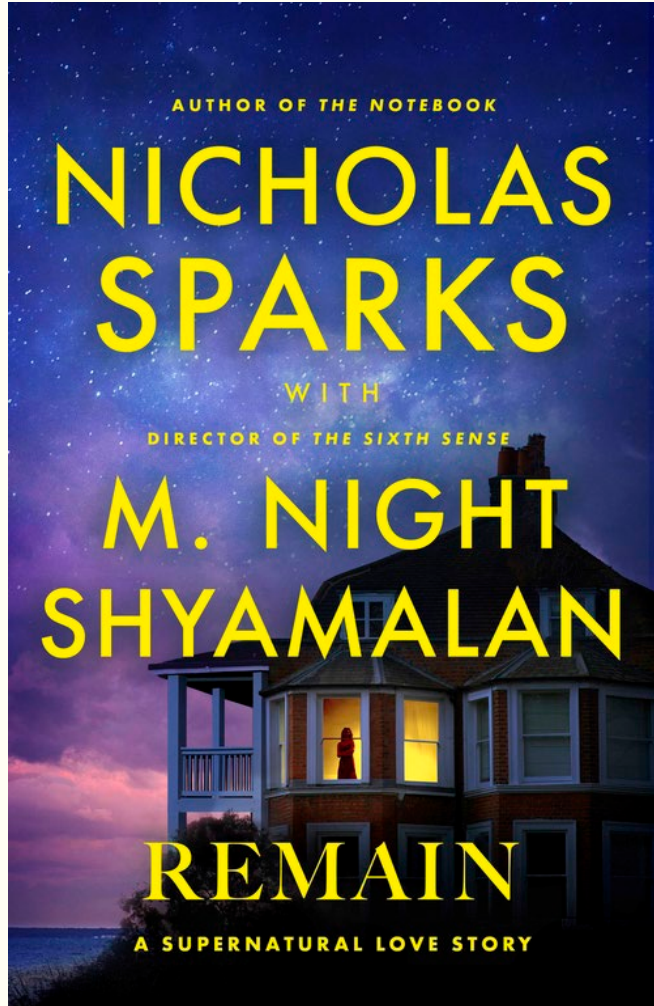

But when Eleanor Barnett, an 85-year-old widow, visits his office to secure a new will, it seems his luck has finally changed: she claims she's sitting on a \$20 million fortune and no one else knows about it. She could be the ticket to his fortune. Once he's hooked the richest client of his career, Simon works quietly to keep her wealth under the radar, even from his own assistant. But there are complications: other lawyers are circling his client like vultures. But when she is hospitalised after a car accident, Eleanor's story begins to crack. Simon realises that nothing is as it seems. And as events spiral out of control, he finds himself on trial for a crime he swears he didn't commit: murder.

The Widow is classic Grisham courtroom drama combined with a confounding murder mystery that will enthrall his legion of fans.

Since *The Firm* in 1991, **John Grisham** has published a number one bestseller every year. His books have been translated into 45 languages and have sold over 350 million copies worldwide. His first work of non-fiction, *The Innocent Man*, was adapted into a six-part Netflix docuseries; his second, *Framed*, highlights work with organisations dedicated to exonerating those who have been wrongfully convicted.

Sharp Force: Scarpetta Bk 29

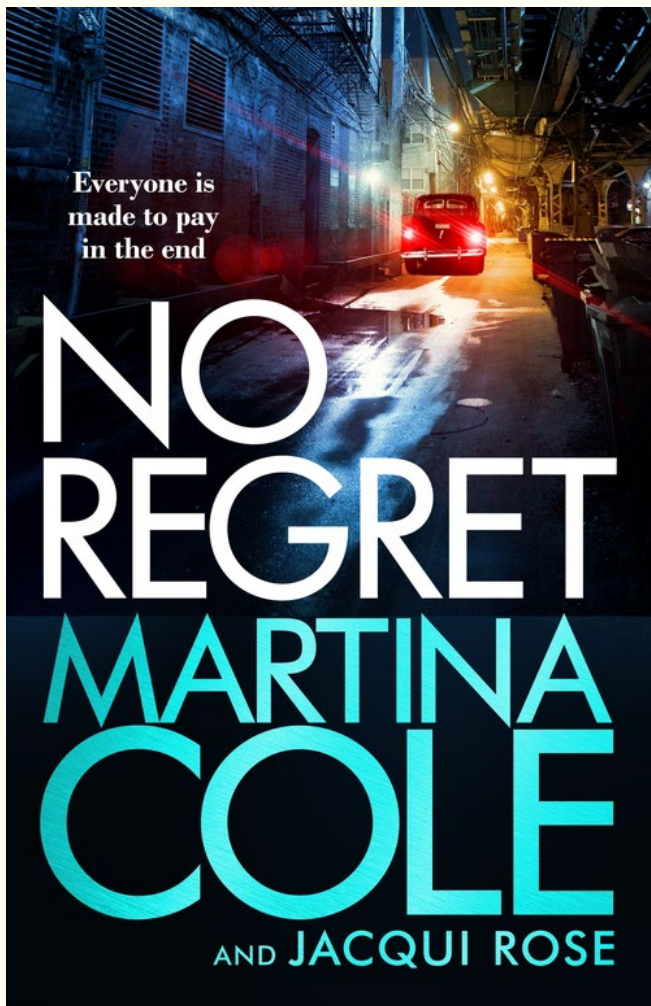

An auspicious debut, it went on to win the Edgar, Creasey, Anthony, and Macavity Awards, as well as the French Prix du Roman d'Aventures - the first book ever to claim all these distinctions in a single year. Growing into an international phenomenon, the Scarpetta series won Cornwell the Sherlock Award for best detective created by an American author, the Gold Dagger Award, the RBA Thriller Award, and the Medal of Chevalier of the Order of Arts and Letters for her contributions to literary and artistic development.

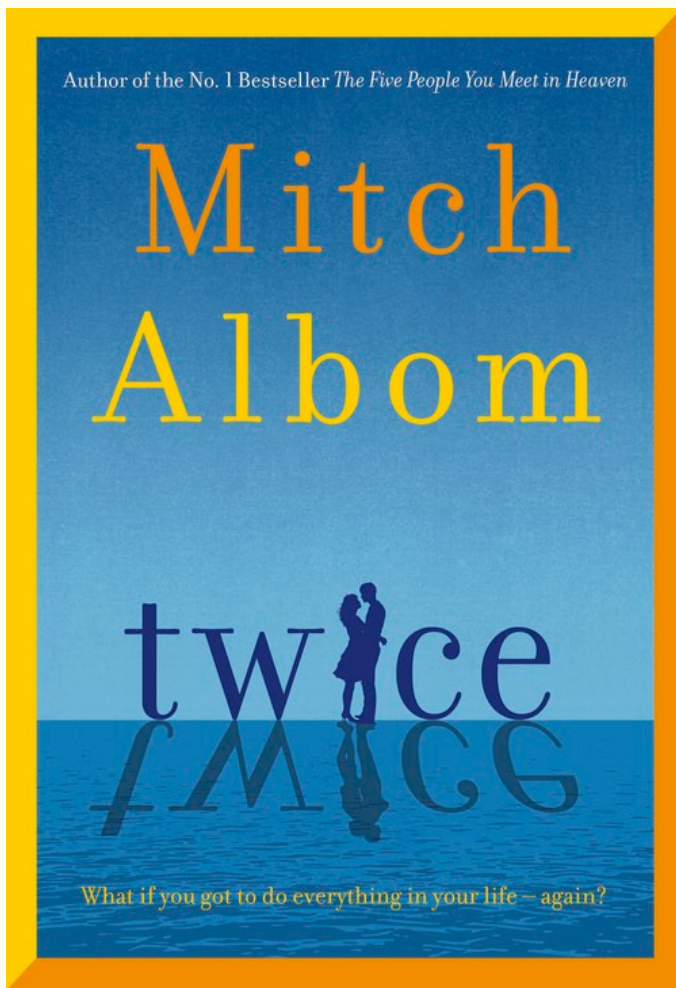

Bog Queen

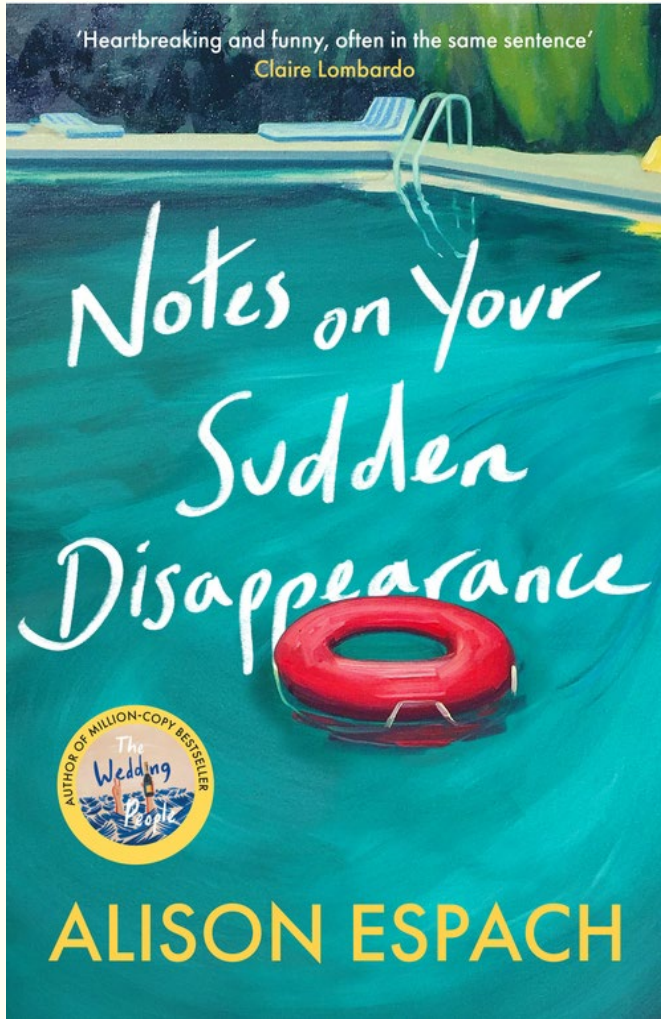

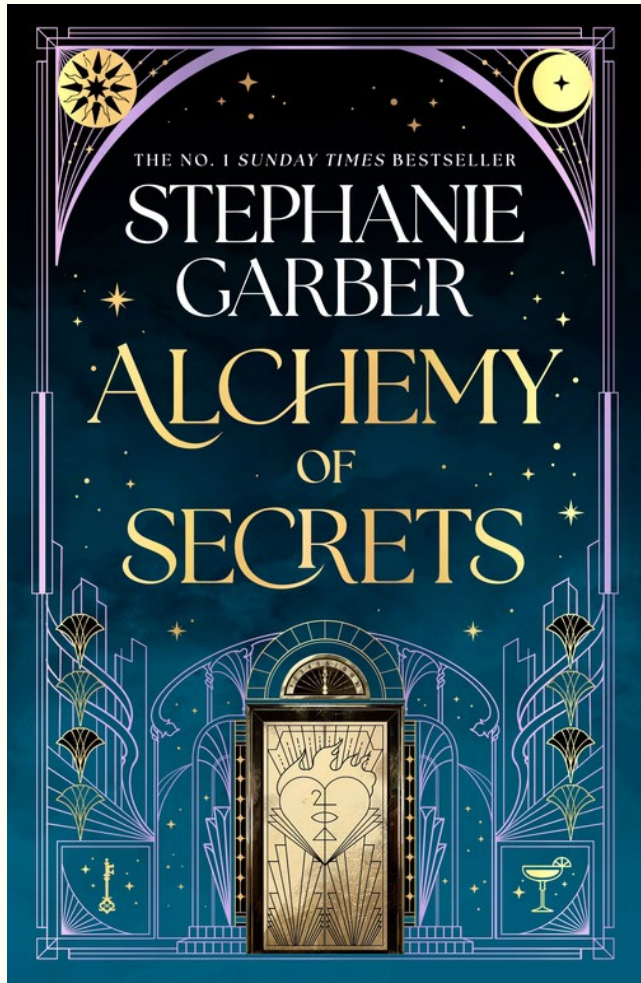
Notes on Your Sudden Disappearance

Fawlty Towers

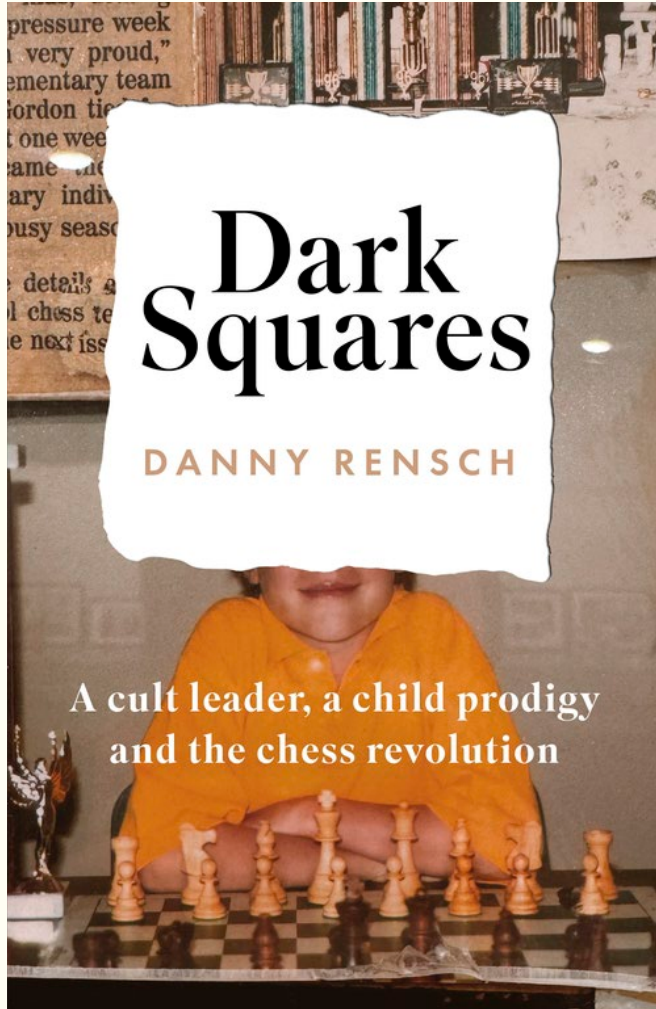

Fifty years ago Fawlty Towers hit British TV screens for the first time, becoming an instant classic. John Cleese was born and brought up in Weston-super-Mare. However, he recovered enough to win a place to study science at Cambridge. The success of the 1963 Cambridge Footlights Revue, which played in the West End and on Broadway, saved him from a legal career. He co-founded the legendary Monty Python comedy troupe, writing and performing in the TV series and films. In the 1970s Cleese and his first wife, Connie Booth, co-wrote and starred in the now-classic sitcom Fawlty Towers, which won three BAFTAs. He went on to appear in many other films, from James Bond to Harry Potter, and guest-starred in numerous TV shows, including Cheers and Will and Grace.

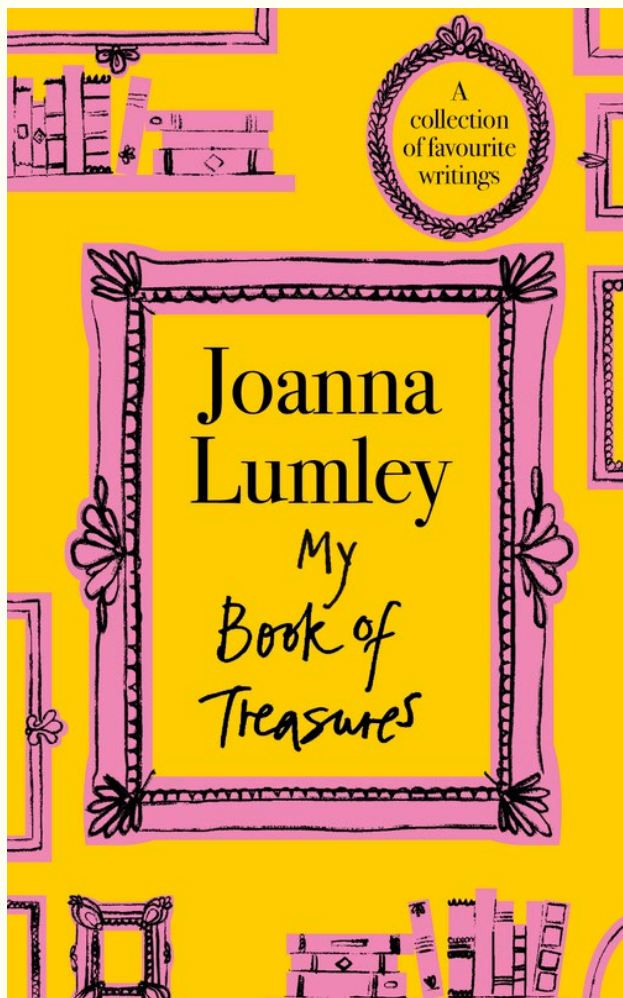

My Book of Treasures

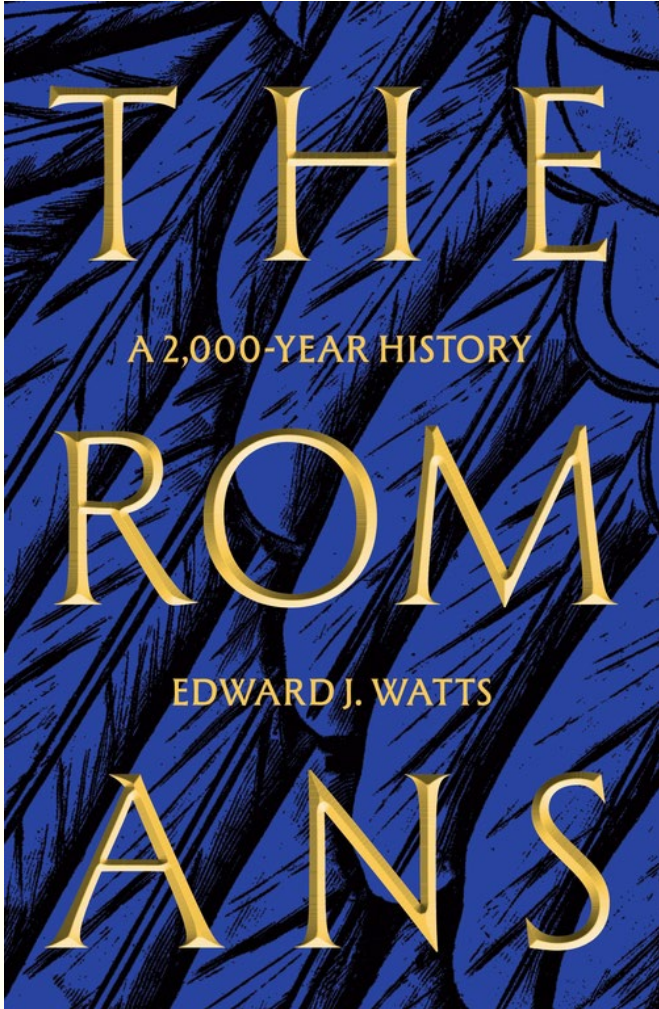

The Romans

When we think of "ancient Romans" today, many picture the toga-clad figure of a Cicero or a Caesar, presiding over a Republic, and then an Empire, before seeing their world collapse at the hands of barbarians in the fifth century. *The Romans* does away with this narrow vision, offering the first comprehensive account of ancient Rome over the course of two millennia.

Prizewinning historian Edward J. Watts recounts the full sweep of Rome's epic past: the Punic Wars, the fall of the Republic, the coming of Christianity, Alaric's sack of Rome, the rise of Islam, the Battle of Manzikert, and the onslaught of the Crusades, which would ultimately lead to the empire's final end.

Watts shows that the source of Rome's enduring strength was the diverse range of people who all called themselves Romans. This is the Rome of Augustus, Marcus Aurelius, and Constantine, but also Charlemagne, Justinian, and Manuel Komemnos - and countless other men and women who together made it the most resilient state the world has ever seen.

Edward J. Watts holds the Alkiviadis Vassiliadis Endowed Chair and is professor of history at the University of California, San Diego. The author and editor of several prize-winning books, including *Mortal Republic*, he lives in Carlsbad, California.

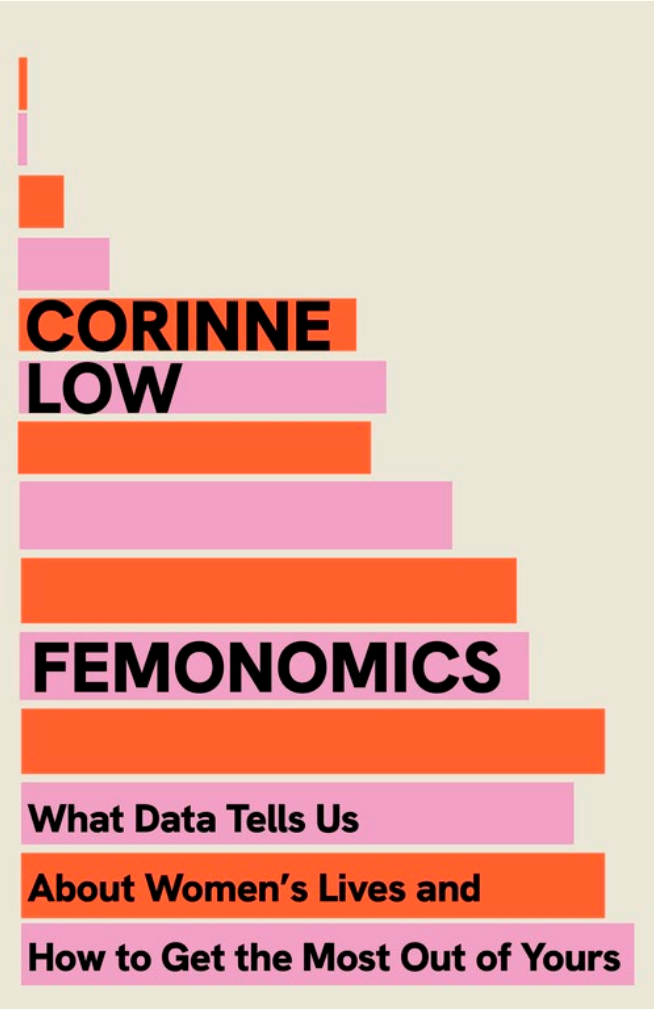

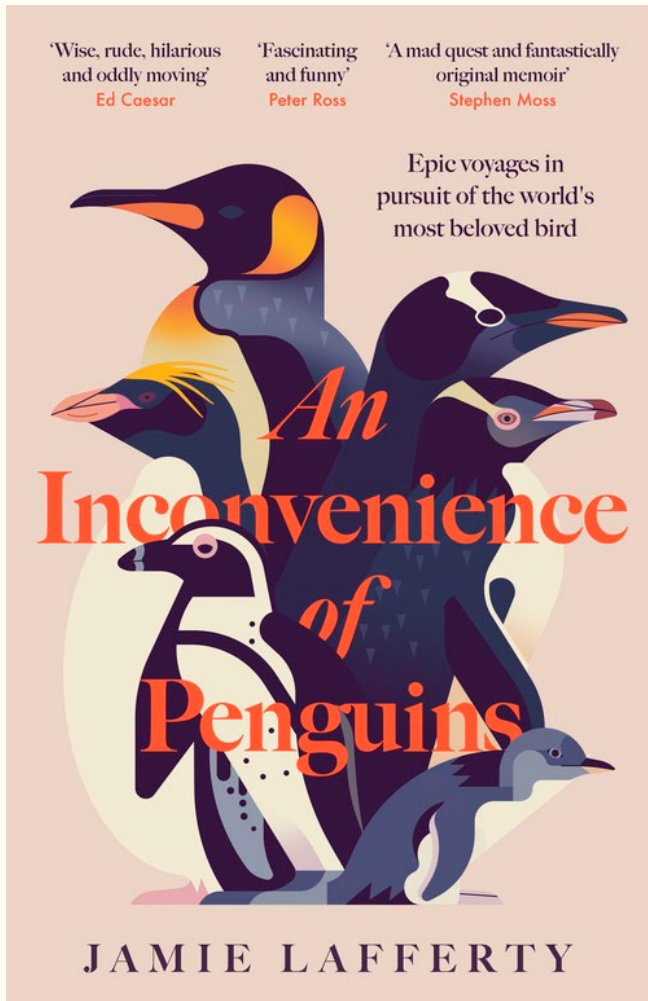

An Inconvenience of Penguins

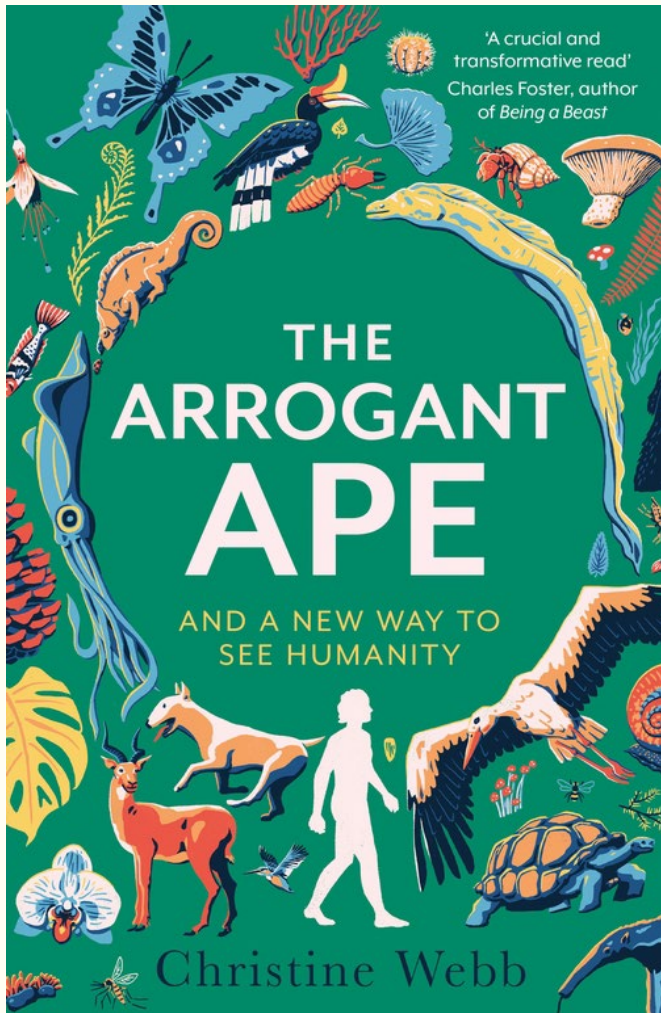

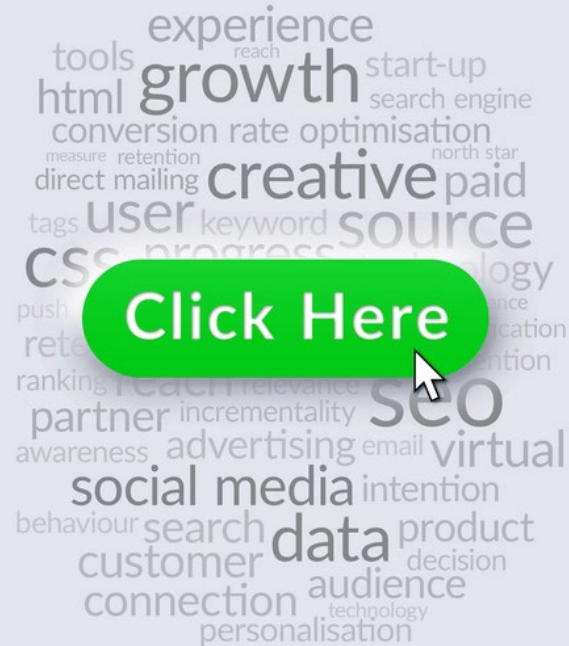

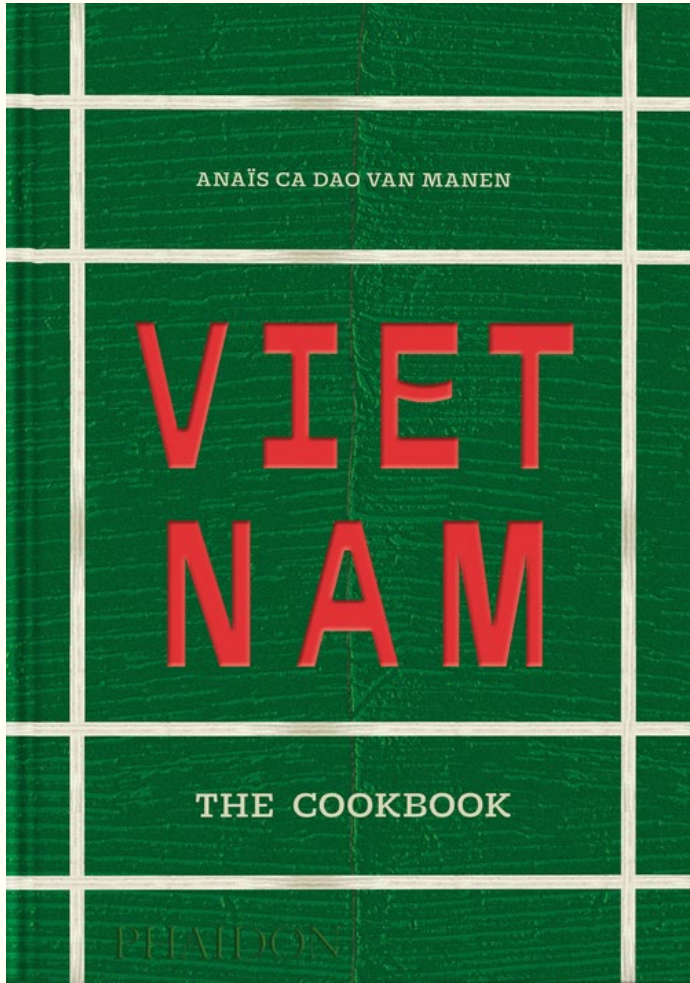
