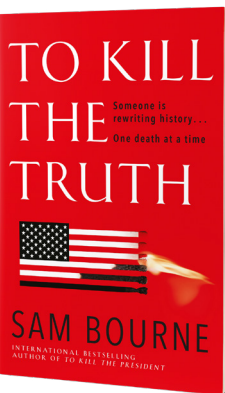


## Swallowtail Summer

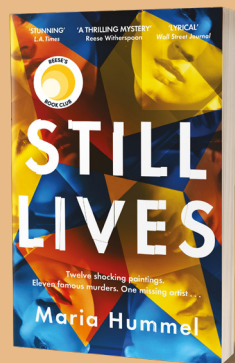
**The Things We Cannot Say**
