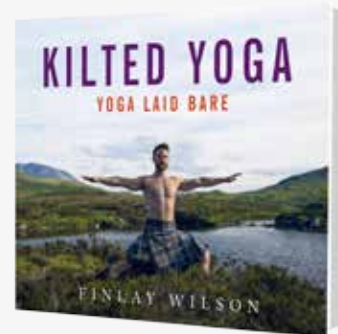

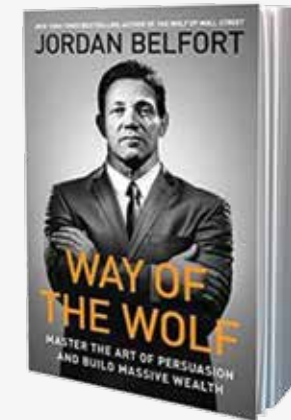
Inspired by the author's own experience of life in Singapore and extensive research, it is an eye-opening novel about life as a modern day maid.

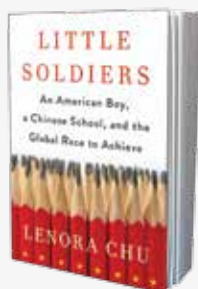
Safe

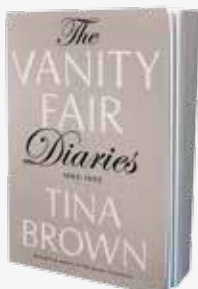
Little Soldiers

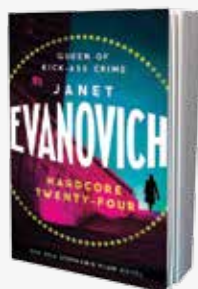

This is a brilliantly dark, high concept literary thriller, and a must-read for fans of Shirley Jackson and Lionel Shriver.



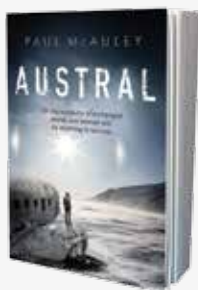
Edge of Darkness
